#### **2023 RESEARCH AWARDS**

Deadline: October 17, 2022

Bridge Award \$100,000/1 Year | Junior Faculty, Mid-career

Bridge funding for investigators revising NIH R (or other federal equivalent) applications.

#### Deadline: December 5, 2022

Afdhal/McHutchison LIFER

\$100,000/2 Years (\$50K/year) | Fellows/Postdocs

Funding for postdoctoral/clinical research fellows pursuing clinical, translational and/or outcomes-related research projects.

Autoimmune Liver Diseases Exploratory Research Award \$20,000/1 Year | Pre-doc/Graduate, Residents, Fellows/Postdocs, Jr. Faculty Supplementary funding for pilot projects in autoimmune liver diseases.

Clinical, Translational and Outcomes Research Award in Liver Diseases \$200,000/2 Years (\$100K/year) | Junior Faculty

Funding for junior faculty performing clinical, translational or outcomes research projects. Applications in health disparities-related research are encouraged. One award per year is reserved for meritorious transplant-related research.

Gupta Family Pilot Award in PSC Research \$50,000/1 Year | Fellows/Postdocs, Junior Faculty, Mid-career

Funding for highly innovative projects in Primary Sclerosing Cholangitis-related research with little or no preliminary data.

Pilot Research Award in Liver Diseases \$50,000/1 Year | Junior Faculty, Mid-career

Supports acquisition of key preliminary data to support a future larger study. Research focus must be clearly different from PI's existing research portfolio.

**Pinnacle Research Award in Liver Diseases** 

\$300,000/3 Years (\$100K/year)| Junior Faculty Funding for junior faculty performing basic science research.
